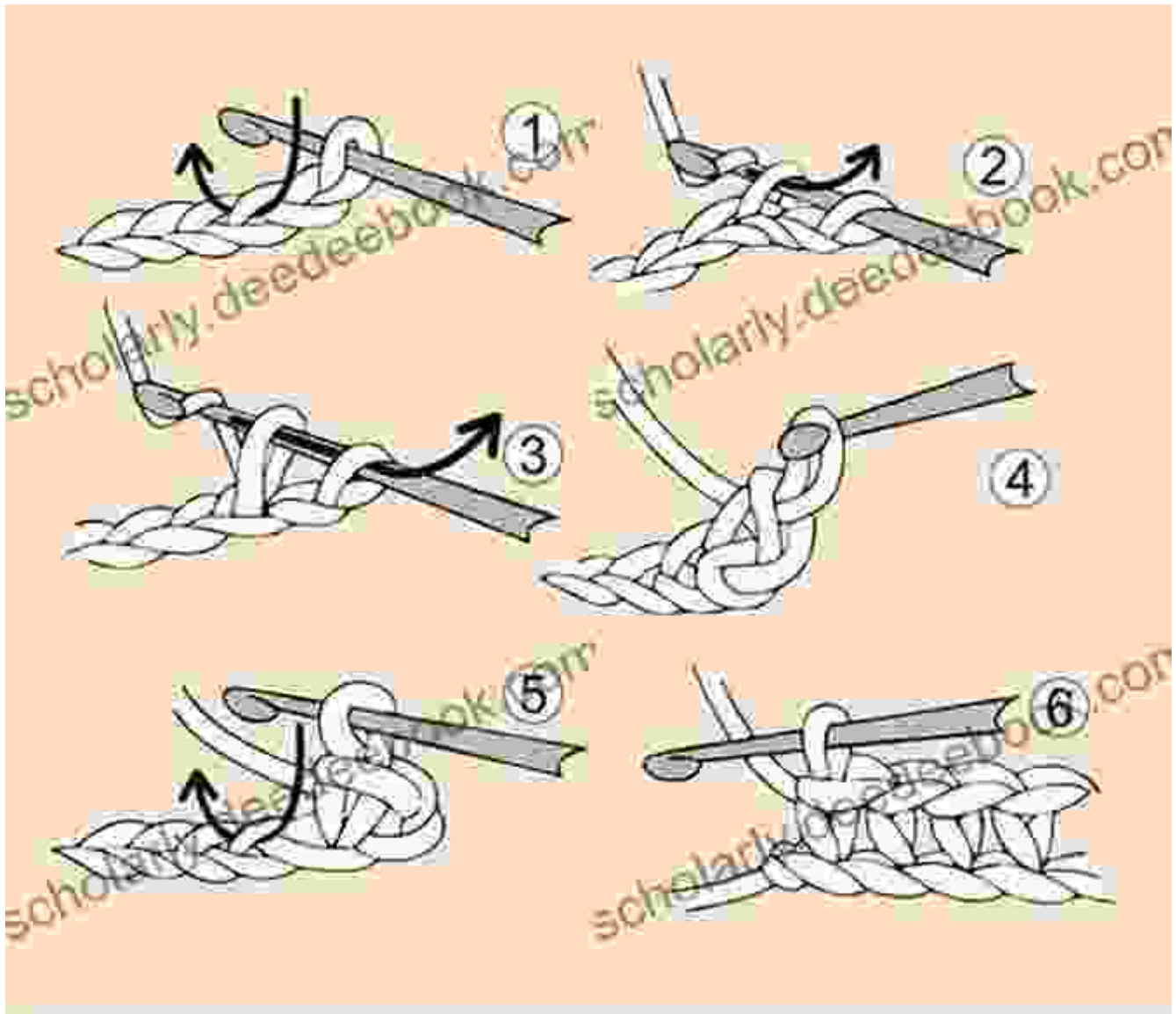

3. Half Double Crochet (hdc)

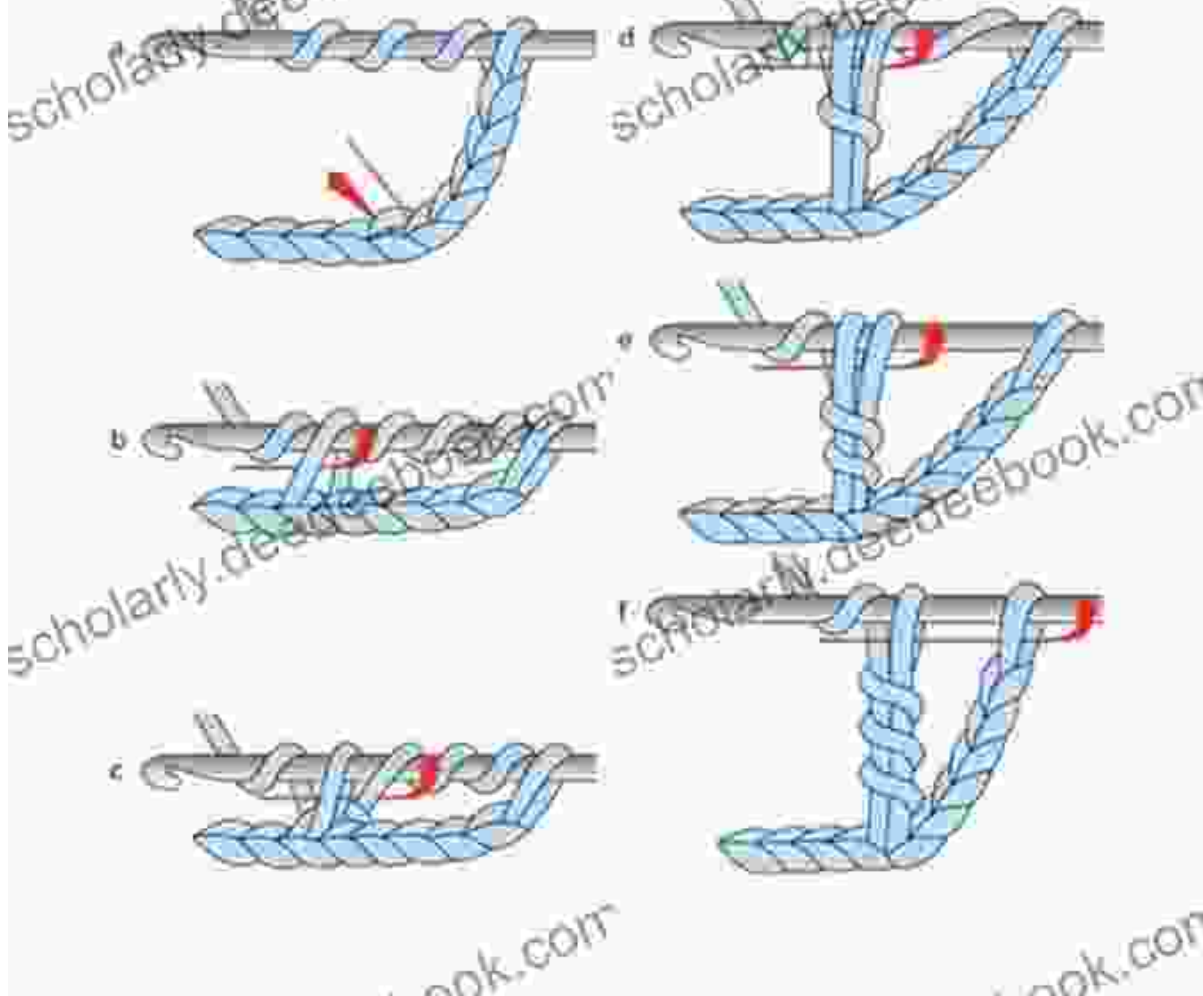


1. Yo and insert the hook into the next stitch on the row.

3. Yo and pull through three loops on the hook.

4. Treble Crochet (tr)

Double treble crochet is a basic crochet stitch. Follow the instructions or watch the video to learn how to double treble crochet.

Yo hook 3 times, insert crochet hook in st (a), yo, draw lp through (b), yo, draw through 2 lps on hook] 4 times (c, d, e, f).



1. Yo twice and insert the hook into the next stitch on the row.
2. Yo and pull up a loop.
3. Repeat step 2 three times.
4. Yo and pull through the first two loops on the hook.
5. Yo and pull through the remaining three loops on the hook.

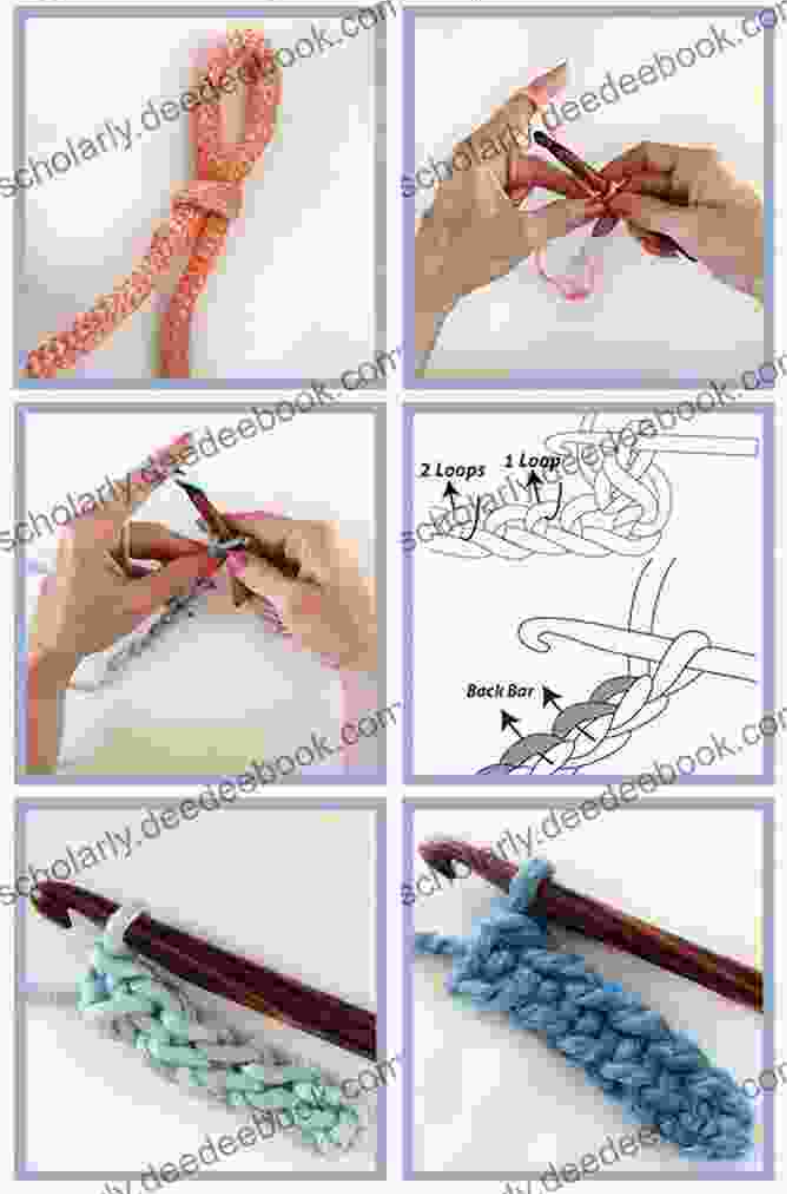
1. Granny Square

2. Coaster

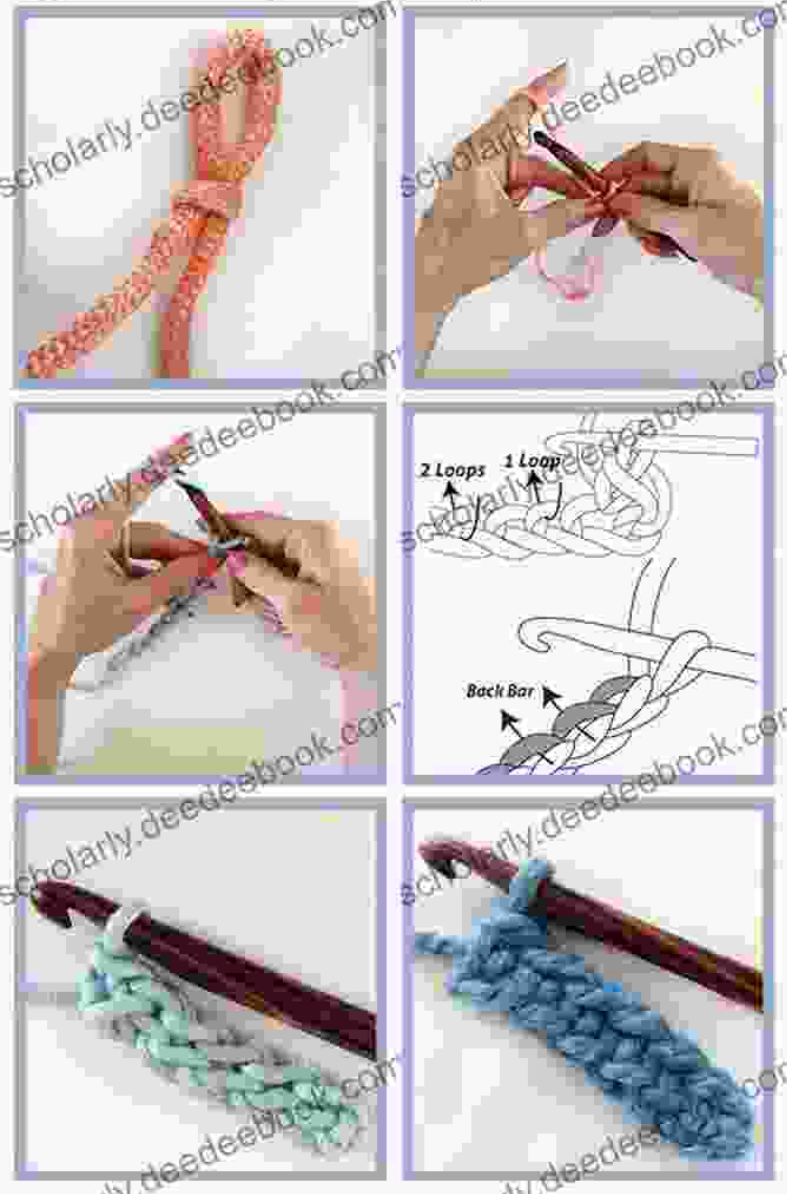

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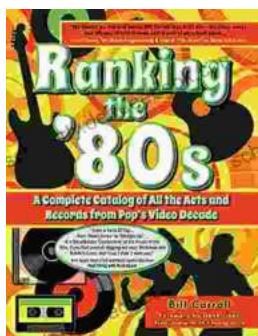
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
