Superman

1. Start by drawing a circle for the head. Add two small ovals for the ears, and draw a curved line for the chin.

3. Draw a trapezoid for the torso, and add two small rectangles for the arms. Draw two small ovals for the hands.
4. Draw a triangle for the web shooters, and add two small ovals for the legs. Draw two small rectangles for the feet.
5. Add any additional details, such as the Spider-Man symbol on the chest and the web lines on the body.

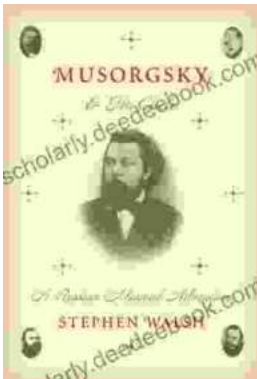

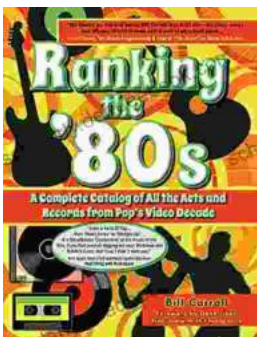
