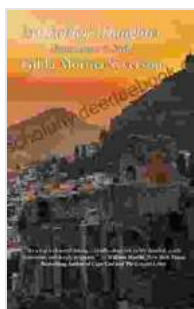

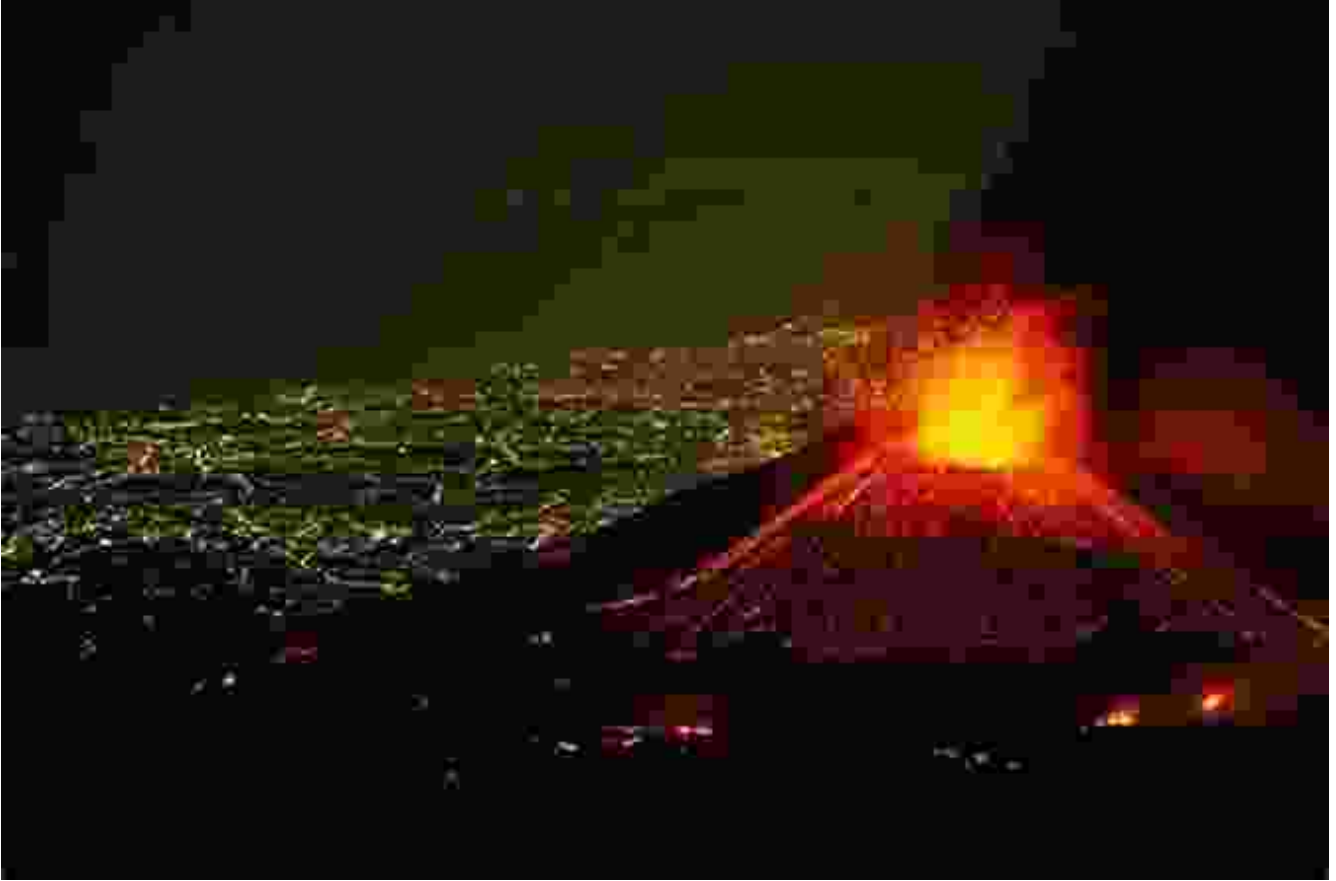
### **Sicily: A Land of Sun, Sea, and History**

### **A Journey of Discovery and Connection**

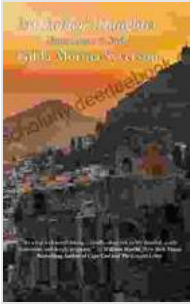

To my father and daughter, I am eternally grateful for sharing this unforgettable journey with me. It was a gift that I will cherish always.



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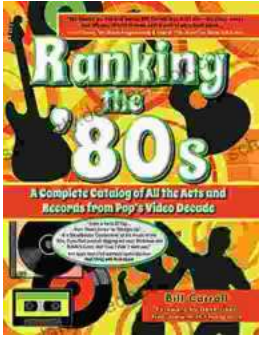
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
